課程簡介

《新港台急診住院醫師交流論壇》源自 2018 年於台灣與香港急診醫學年會中舉辦的交流活動，致力於促進急診住院醫師之間的國際交流與合作。2020 年因應 COVID-19 疫情，論壇首次轉為線上形式舉行；自 2021 年起，新加坡急診醫師加入，發展為三方定期交流的重要平台。

本論壇旨在提供住院醫師分享臨床經驗、交流專業知識與拓展國際人脈的機會。過往論壇主題多由新加坡、香港與台灣住院醫師透過社群媒體票選產生，反映當年度最受關注的急診議題。本次特別選用過去呼聲極高卻未能入選的主題——「急診 POCUS：機會與挑戰」作為討論核心。

論壇將由三地住院醫師分別分享各自醫療體系中相關議題的現況與挑戰，並進一步展開跨區域綜合討論。新加坡、香港與台灣在地理與文化上相近，然於醫療制度與臨床實務上仍各具特色。透過此類比較與交流，不僅能深化與會者的理解，也有助於拓展對急診醫學多元面向的思考。

The Emergency Medicine Residents Forum has been held since 2018, rotating between the annual emergency medicine conferences in Taiwan and Hong Kong. In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Forum transitioned to a virtual or hybrid format in 2020. Since 2021, emergency medicine residents from Singapore have formally joined, establishing a trilateral platform for ongoing collaboration.

The Forum provides a valuable opportunity for residents from Singapore, Hong Kong, and Taiwan to share clinical knowledge, exchange experiences, and build professional networks. In previous years, discussion topics were selected through social media polls, allowing residents across all three regions to vote on areas of greatest interest. This year, the Forum will focus on a previously highly ranked yet unselected topic: "POCUS in the Emergency Department: Opportunities and Obstacles."

During the session, residents from each region will present the current state and key challenges of POCUS in their respective emergency departments, followed by a moderated panel discussion featuring representatives from all three regions. While Singapore, Hong Kong, and Taiwan share geographic and cultural similarities, differences in their healthcare systems and clinical practices often generate meaningful comparisons—offering participants broader perspectives and deeper insights into emergency medicine.
